Item Description: Allocation of U1 General Fund Revenues

Submitted by: Vice Mayor Sophie Hahn

A revision is proposed to frontload existing allocations for the Small Sites Program to FY 2020, to better position the City to take advantage of Small Sites opportunities which are likely to become available in the next few years.

On Nov. 21, 2019, the Land Use, Housing & Economic Development Policy Committee recommended Council allocations for U1-generated general funds, including projected allocations for Berkeley's Small Sites Project, which provides funds to non-profit developers to acquire small multi-unit properties and reserve them for low-income individuals and families.

The Committee recommended three \$1M allocations over three years (FY 21, FY22 and FY23) to the Small Sites Program. This proposal suggests allocating the same total amount of funds, \$3M, in FY 2020. The funds are already available, and would otherwise remain "unallocated" in the General Fund. This slight amendment allows existing funds to be put to use sooner rather than later, helping meet the need for affordable housing more quickly. The revision does not change the four-year overall projections, as the total amount recommended for allocation does not change; only the timing.
